Risk: In an emergency situation
If Clients or Staff have accident or sickness

Safety Measures in Place:

1. ALL staff carry mobile phone whilst on duty (day or nights) and ensure fully charged prior to commencement of shift.
2. ALL staffs have A & T Caring Services **On Call / Out of hours** contact number 01344666061 on speed dial
3. West **Call OUT OF HOURS GP**
4. ALL staffs have emergency services (police number) on speed dial **999**
5. ALL staff to log –in with the On call person before the commencement of the night shift, and on arrival at home after finishing the evening shift)

Benefits of Safety Measures

Day and Night staff can press Contact Emergency Services or On Call person or alert others at any time in an emergency situation.
